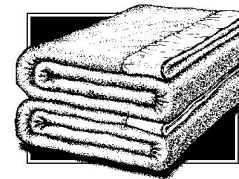
The Women's Bible Study led by Beth Hooker will be meeting on Wednesday, February 11 at 4:00 p.m. All are welcome!!
